It is our immense pleasure to be able to introduce to you our God-sent addition to our family this last month. Hadassah Abigail Nickell was born on July 30th, measuring 7lb 10oz and 20.8 inches long. While there were initial, minor concerns for both Katrina and Hadassah immediately after delivery, both recovered and improved quickly. **Thank you to all who have prayed for this special moment for our family to be a time of blessing and health.** Hadassah is growing well and is capturing our hearts, including those of the Thai people. While a baby shower is uncommon to Thailand, the Thai people of Cha-Am Baptist Church graced us with a special service to celebrate Katrina and the newborn baby.

The Lord continues to work in drawing people to Him, and we are privileged to be used in casting the net of the Gospel out to catch some souls for Christ. It has been greatly encouraging to see the Student Center Ministry on Saturdays grow as both adults and children have been added to the weekly classes. This is one of our primary evangelistic ministries as we teach English free to anyone who wants come to the church to learn. After English class, we then are able to share a Bible lesson and Gospel presentation. **Our first year of experience in this ministry saw a constant revolving door of students; whereas these last few months we have seen new faces added to the class and continue to attend weeks later. Please pray that their weekly contact with Scripture will produce a personal decision for Christ!**



Please pray for the young man in the picture above who is wearing a jacket. His name is Game, and we have requested prayer for him in the past. He began attending the English class last year but has been away for the last few months due to work. He surprised us earlier this month when he was back in the area and came to our Saturday ministry. After class, **Brother Mike Leemon and I spoke with him about his eternal soul. He said he believed and wanted to accept salvation from Jesus! Please pray that there will be fruit that remains from this decision.** While he made a profession of faith in a private room to us, he is very concerned with being publicly baptized.
